

JANE CANFIELD is a New Zealand born painter. Canfield relocated to Sydney to complete her Graphic Design College (Randwick TAFE, Sydney 1984). Throughout this time Canfield was producing artworks, becoming renowned for her strong linocut prints and in 2004 Canfield became a full time artist exhibiting in commercial galleries and regional galleries throughout Australia. She has received accolades for her paintings and drawings that are informed from her love of nature. She was inspired throughout her life by her father Tony Canfield who was a collected artist, inventor, motor mechanic and designer.

Canfield is a WIRES volunteer (particularly interested in Flying Foxes and Bats) and is one of the founding volunteer directors on the Katoomba & Upper Blue Mountains Bendigo Community Bank Branch which returns thousands of dollars every year to not-for-profit and community groups in the region.
